

## Another way to reach-

The Venue DMIC Jamboree site is located from Pali Railway Station's on Pali Jodhpur road which is located at Main NH 62. Jamboree site can be reached by crossing Rohat Village on Pali Jodhpur National Highway No. 62. The distance between Pali Railway station and Jamboree site is 38 km.

1. Road, Train & Air transportation is available to reach Jodhpur from all States. The nearest airport to Jamboree site is Jodhpur Airport. The distance between Airport and Jamboree site is 39 Km.
2. Road & Train transportation is available to reach Pali from all States.
3. Bus, Car and Truck will be available at jodhpur and Pali Railway station for Jamboree site. The payment however has to be made by the participants.

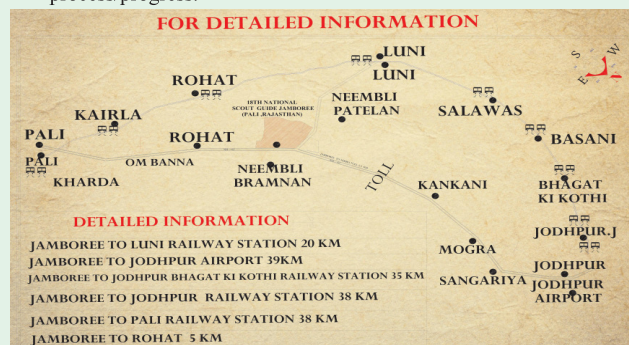
### ii. Group activities (Wing wise)

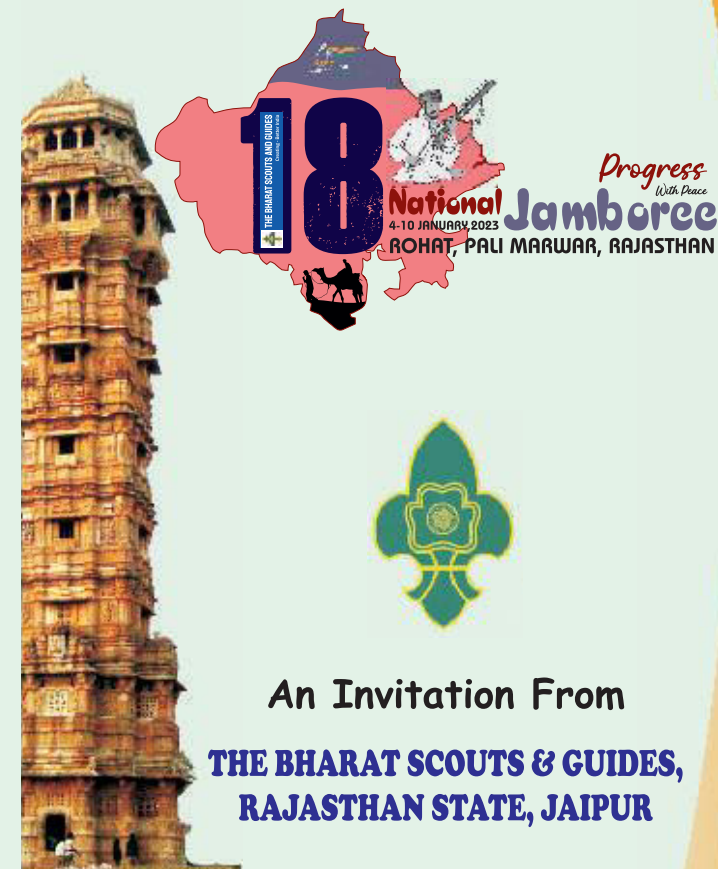

## General Information at a glance

### An overview of Rajasthan: -

Rajasthan is situated in the west of the country. Rajasthan has an international border with Pakistan, 1,070 km. in the west. It is surrounded by Punjab, Haryana, UP, MP and Gujrat State.

It is spread over an area of 342,239 Sq.km.. The vibrant state of Rajasthan is currently home to 80,782,495 people in 2021.

Geographically it is the largest State of the country. It should go without saying that Rajasthan has become synonymous with the great Indian Thar Desert, but this hardly presents a true picture of its multifaceted topography. The spectacle is varied and comprises not only the Thar Desert (in the west) but also includes the Aravallies (amongst the world's oldest mountain ranges) covering the entire south to the north expanse of the State before tapering off in Delhi.

Rajasthan's golden soil echoes the history of bygone eras. One of mankind's earliest civilizations, the Indus valley, had its base in Rajasthan. Famed for its architectural ground, Rajasthan is a home of beautiful places and forts.

The state is a proud representative of a secular land. A home to sacrosanct Sufi shrine of Khwaja Moinuddin Chisti in Ajmer, Jain temples of Ranakpur and Mt. Abu and India's only Brahma Temple in Pushkar, a huge number of pilgrims throng here every year for holy pilgrimage.

It needs no reiteration that Rajasthan is a play home to wild life in the sanctuaries, as well as its natural surroundings. From the majestic Indian Tiger to beautiful blackbucks, a camel (popularly known as the ship of the desert) and the endangered great Indian Bustard; as you go around exposing the wild, Rajasthan brings you closer to nature.

This land of erst while Royalty carries a rich legacy of traditional jewellery. Popular for Kundan, Meena, Thewa, and Silver Jewellery. It is also renowned as a land of richly talented craftsmen.

Rajasthan is a land of colors. Colorful dances, soul-stirring music, lovely ornaments and high-spirited people, all from the soul of Rajasthan's fair and festivals.

The land celebrates festive occasions all year around. This land of Warriors has its own unique cultural identity. From the famous Kalbelia dance to the enthralling Folk music of Langas and Managariyars, Rajasthan is where you experience culture unplugged.

## A brief glimpses of Pali

### Pali District Location

Pali is located in the south western side of Rajasthan. It is surrounded by Nagaur District to the north, Ajmer District to the northeast, Rajsamand District to the east, Udaipur District to the southeast, Sirohi District to the southwest, Jalore District and Barmer District to the west, and Jodhpur District to the northwest.

### Pali District Climate

In the month of January there is a winter season. The weather is quite cold. At night the temperature in Pali is approximately 7 to 10 Degree Celsius & at day time it is 10 to 25 Degree Celsius. Please bring adequate woollen clothes.

### Transportation in Pali District

Pali is well connected by road and railways. Regular government and private buses are available to other major cities. Pali railway station connects Pali with all the major cities of Rajasthan and rest of India. Jodhpur airport is the nearest airport to Pali district.
